Reading

As Literacy Coordinator for the school I am required to regularly check on teaching and learning in the subject. I have recently completed a review on reading in the school.

We teach the 'mechanics' of reading through daily phonics sessions in Maple Class and intervention phonics sessions in the Key Stage 2 classes, as well as shared and guided reading sessions, in all classes, throughout the week. We also listen to individual children read their reading books if deemed necessary.

On inspection of your children's home reading records, and speaking to the children, it has come to my attention that many children are not doing the required home reading practise needed to maintain progress in reading.

Please may I remind you that your child should be reading EVERY night at home – from Reception right through to Year 6:

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2
Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

15 minutes per night
a minimum of 20 minutes per night

Reading records should be filled in by you, the parent, with dates, page numbers, successes and difficulties that your child may have encountered.
