We will be highlighting transport to school options over Term 6 as we did last year:

- We will be taking part in the **Giant Walking Bus on Wednesday 10th June 2015**. This is part of a nationwide event organised by BRAKE the road safety charity. **The Giant Walking Bus will leave school at 1.15 p.m.** and we will walk into the village and back to school. We will use the event to march for road safety in Moulton Chapel and children may make placards with "Slow Down" or "30 mph" or other safety messages on them to highlight to drivers the speed restrictions that apply in the village and outside our school and the need to take care to keep children safe when they are walking or cycling. **If you would like to join us for the Giant Walking Bus you are very welcome to do so.**
- **Each child who walks, cycles (or "scoots") to school over Term 6 will receive a sticker on their own reward card (given to your child today).** When 5 stickers have been achieved they may choose a reflective reward from a selection we have in school. **Remember your child must wear a cycle helmet if they cycle or scoot – and they will not receive a sticker if they cycle or scoot to school without a helmet!**
- **Bikeability** took place in April so almost all the children in Years 5 and 6 are now Level 1 or Level 2 certificate holders. Well done! Keep cycling safely please – and always wear a helmet!
