We will be focusing on various other things of course; please see the attached "overview" for more detail.

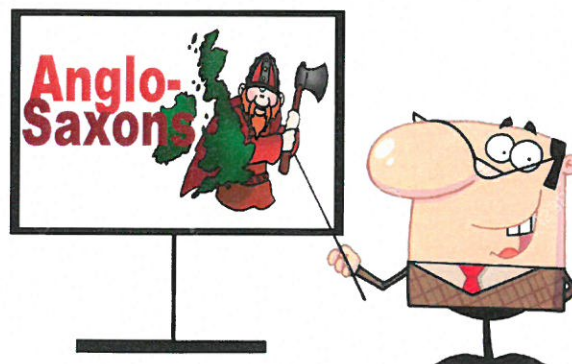
There will be no swimming this term, but we will still have 2 PE days: Thursdays and Fridays.
