Lots of things happening between now and the end of Term 2:

Secret Room

We are continuing the popular Secret Room this year. This is a part of school from which parents are banned! Children go in at certain times and buy small presents up to the value of £1.00 for their parents and brothers/sisters (*please don't extend beyond these as our stock is limited!*) without their parents knowing – it is the child's secret. poster that will be displayed in the school for all their friends and staff to see.



Christmas Carol Service: 9th December 2021

This year our Christmas celebration will be a Carol Service on the school playground. It will start at 6.00 p.m. and will last for around one hour. The children will sing and read poems/letters etc., for you and Friends of School will be providing hot drinks and mince pies. The Raffle will be drawn during the event. Your child will need to return to school for 5.45 p.m. warmly dressed including a hat and scarf – Christmassy if possible. *If the weather is really not suitable on the 9th we are keeping the 13th as a reserve date for the event.*
