RECEPTION, YEAR 1 AND YEAR 2

Dear Parents and Children

Welcome back to a brand-new topic, in a brand-new term, in a brand-new year! We have lots of new and exciting things planned for the children in their new topic.

This term our topic is '<u>People who help us</u>.' Connected to our topic we are going to find out about the police force and check our fingerprints, to know how to prevent fires and what to do if you discover a fire, to know how to keep good dental hygiene, discover how a teacher helps their class and the role of a doctor in helping us stay healthy. They will need to bring correct swimwear and a towel, and could we please request that the girls <u>do</u> <u>not wear tights</u> on a Wednesday when they are swimming. Thank you for your support. The children will continue to have PE with Mr Dyer on a Wednesday afternoon. Please ensure your child is wearing a full PE kit in the correct school colours, and please remove your child's earrings on Wednesdays for swimming and PE, thank you.)

Reception Parents, please could I remind you that your child needs a spare set of clothes, including underwear and socks, also to be kept at school in your child's locker. This always proves very useful, especially for those children keen to use the water tray, should they be unfortunate enough to fall over on the wet, muddy playground or field as well as those other 'inevitable' accidents!
